Dear parents and carers,

We are writing to let you know about changes to our Breakfast Club and Wraparound Care provision from September.

As a school, we are committed to providing high-quality, affordable childcare that supports our families before and after the school day. We understand how important these services are, and we have worked hard to keep our charges as low as possible.

Our charges for Breakfast Club and Wraparound Care have remained unchanged since 2022. Despite significant increases in staffing, food, utilities and other operating costs during that time, we have avoided passing these costs on to families. However, the Governing Board has recently reviewed the provision and has agreed that a price increase is now necessary to ensure that we can continue to offer a high-quality, sustainable service.

From September, the cost of all Breakfast Club and Wraparound Care sessions will increase by 5%. This decision has not been taken lightly. The revised charges will help us to continue providing a safe, caring and high-quality service for our children while meeting the increasing costs of delivering it. The increase also brings our charges into line with those of the other primary schools within our Multi-Academy Trust (MAT).

The new charges from September are:

- Breakfast Club: £5.25
- Wraparound Care (until 4.30pm): £6.30
- Wraparound Care (until 6.00pm): £10.50

We would also like to let you know that, from September, Wraparound Care will be based in the school hall. The space currently used for Wraparound Care will be used as a classroom to accommodate the growing needs of the school. We are confident that the hall will continue to provide an excellent environment for the children, with plenty of space for a wide range of activities and opportunities to play, learn and relax at the end of the school day.

We appreciate that any increase in costs can have an impact on families, and we hope you understand the reasons for these changes. We remain committed to offering excellent childcare that provides a safe, welcoming and enjoyable experience for all children and represents good value for families.
